Respiratory			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Abnormal/fast breathing</li> </ul>
Skin	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Normal skin colour</li> <li>Warm extremities</li> </ul>		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Pale / mottled / blue</li> <li>Cold extremities</li> </ul>
Rash	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>No amber features</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Is painful</li> <li>Is blistering</li> <li>Covers most of their body</li> <li>Has red lips or tongue</li> <li>Has skin peeling</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Does not disappear with pressure</li> </ul>
Other	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>No amber features</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Additional parent/carer concerns</li> <li>Has had chicken pox in the last few days and is getting worse</li> <li>Age 3-6 months with temp <math>\geq 39^{\circ}</math> (<math>102.2^{\circ}\text{F}</math>) with no clear focus of infection</li> <li>Fever <math>&gt;5</math> days</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Age 0-3 months with temp <math>\geq 38^{\circ}</math> (<math>100.4^{\circ}\text{F}</math>)</li> </ul>
